On December 6, 1990, an appeal was filed with the Environmental Board by Willard and Diana Hunnewell through their attorney, Thomas Amidon, from Land Use Permit Amendment #100035-2, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued by District #5 Environmental Commission on December 5, 1990. The permit authorizes the Permittee to construct a 30' x 60' concrete sludge storage building with a pole barn roof, and to apply sludge to the farm fields, on 70 acres of the 235-acre Mayo Farm tract owned by the Town of Stowe on West Hill Road in Stowe, Vermont.

On January 4, 1991, the Executive Officer, Stephanie J. Kaplan, wrote to Attorney **Amidon** asking him to contact her if he wishes to pursue the appeal. Attorney **Amidon** did not reply to the letter. Dismissal of this appeal will not contravene the values protected by 10 V.S.A. Chapter 151 (Act 250). Therefore, this appeal is dismissed.
