On December 8, 1989, the District #4 Environmental Commission issued Land Use Permit Amendment #4C0424-1-EB to the Town of Charlotte. The permit amendment authorizes the Permittee to operate a municipal landfill on 80 acres of land off Carpenter Road in the Town of Charlotte, Vermont.


On December 29, 1989, the Permittee filed an appeal of the permit amendment. The appeal challenges various permit conditions. These conditions relate to several of the Act 250 criteria found at 10 V.S.A. § 6086(a). On February 7, 1990, Environmental Board Chairman Stephen Reynes convened a preliminary hearing in Charlotte, Vermont.

On February 20, 1990, the Permittee filed a request to withdraw its appeal with respect to permit conditions #11, 18, and 19. The Permittee stated that it wished to proceed on conditions #7, 9, 13, and 15. On February 27, the Board issued a preliminary hearing report. On March 2, 1990, the Agency of Natural Resources filed a notice of appearance in this matter, stating that it sought to raise issues with respect to conditions #9, 11, 13, and 15. On March 7, the Board deliberated concerning the proposed withdrawal and decided that it is not contrary to the values embodied in Act 250.

ORDER

The **Permittee's** appeal is dismissed with respect to permit conditions #11, 18, and 19. The appeal will proceed on conditions #7, 9, 13, and 15 in accordance with the preliminary hearing report.
