PROPOSAL FOR DISMISSAL

On May 19, 1994 Paul and Arlene Hubscher (the Appellants) filed an appeal of Land Use Permit #5L0822-11 issued to Robinson Springs Partnership on April 28, 1994. As grounds for its appeal, the Appellants believe the Commission erred with respect to 10 V.S.A. §6086(a)(8) (aesthetics).

On June 17, 1994 the Appellants filed a stipulation in which the parties agreed to a continuance of this proceeding.

On February 27, 1995 Board Chair Ewing sent a memorandum to the parties stating that on or before March 24, 1995 the Appellants shall file a written update regarding the status of this proceeding.

On February 27, 1995 the permittee filed a letter stating that the Appellants purchased parcel 3 such that the appeal is now moot.

On March 17, 1995 the Appellants filed a letter advising that their appeal is withdrawn.


