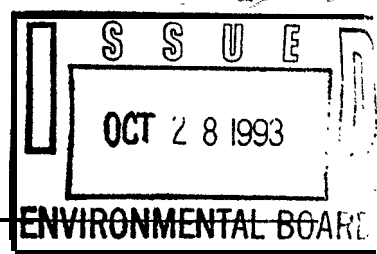

LAND USE PERMIT AMENDMENT (Altered)

The Vermont Environmental Board hereby issues Amended Land Use Permit Amendment #5W0870-13-EB pursuant to the authority vested in it by 10 V.S.A Chapter 151. This permit applies to the lands identified in Book 19, Page 112, of the Land Records of the Town of Cabot, Vermont, as the subject of a deed to Cabot Creamery Cooperative, Inc. (formerly Cabot Farmers' Cooperative Creamery, Inc.), the Permittee, as grantee. This permit amends the conditions of Land Use Permit #5W0870-13, which authorizes the Permittee to use a land application program for the disposal of dairy processing wastewater and washwater resulting from the operation of its production plant in the Village of Cabot, Vermont.

The Permittee, and its assigns and successors in interest, is obliged by this permit to comply with the following conditions:

1. The project shall be completed, operated and maintained in accordance with:
(a) the terms and conditions of Land Use Permit Amendment #5W0870-13, except as amended hereby; (b) the plans, exhibits, and testimony submitted by the Permittee to the Environmental Board; (c) Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law #5W0870-13-EB; and (d) the conditions of this permit amendment. No changes shall be made in the project without the written approval of the District #5 Environmental Commission.
2. Condition #16 of Land Use Permit Amendment #5W0870-13 is modified to read as follows:
 16. The Permittee shall divert all loaded trucks from SA #1 (also known as the Lower Walden Road or South Walden Road) to SA #3 (the Walden Heights Road). During the spring thaw, none of the Permittee's spray trucks, whether loaded or unloaded, shall use SA #1. Twice a year, the Permittee shall send a written report to the Town of Walden Board of Selectmen itemizing how many loaded and unloaded trips are made by its spray trucks on SA #1 and SA #3 within the Town of Walden.

3. Condition #26 is added to Land Use Permit Amendment #5W0870-13, to read as follows:


On or before October 15, 1993, the Permittee shall post, in manner readily visible to spray truck drivers and to the general public, the number of each land application site in the field at the approved spray location. The posting shall be done such that the number of the site will stay in place and be visible throughout the year. The Permittee shall clear the posted numbers of snow as needed.

4. Condition #27 is added to Land Use Permit Amendment #5W0870-13, to read as follows:

On or before October 15, 1993, the Permittee shall assign a number to each spray truck that is used for land application and shall post that number, and the Permittee's name, on the rear and on each side of the spray tank on the truck. The letters used by the Permittee in such posting shall be no less than eight inches high.
