Dismissal Order
Land Use Permit
Amendment
#700002-7-EB

On August 30, 1988, Haystack Group, Inc. (the Permittee) filed with the Environmental Board an appeal of Land Use Permit Amendment #700002-7 issued by the District #2 Environmental Commission on August 2, 1988. The permit amendment authorizes the Permittee to construct a base lodge for the Haystack Ski Area and a parking lot in the Town of Wilmington, Vermont. The Permittee appealed Conditions 7, 8 and 9 of the permit amendment, which impose duties relating to traffic pursuant to Criterion 5. Also on August 30, the Town of Wilmington appealed Conditions 7 and 8 of the permit amendment.

A public hearing was scheduled in this matter for November 3, 1988. However, this hearing was not held because the Permittee filed a letter on October 31 stating that it would no longer seek to proceed with its appeal. On November 22, the Town of Wilmington filed a letter indicating that it sought to withdraw its appeal.

The Board understands that withdrawal of this appeal is sought because the District Commission has agreed to revise the permit amendment. The Board is informed that the permit amendment is being revised only with regard to Condition 7 and that the revision is designed to prevent unsafe traffic conditions and unreasonable congestion. On this basis, the Board determines that withdrawal of the appeal is not contrary to the intent or purposes of Act 250 or the Board's rules. Therefore, the appeals in this matter are hereby dismissed.
