NOTICE OF JURISDICTIONAL OPINION RECONSIDERATION

The Vermont Natural Resources Board (Board) has received a request from Moretown Landfill, Inc. (Requestor) to reconsider Jurisdictional Opinion #5-27(the JO). The JO, issued by the District 5 Assistant Coordinator on September 27, 2013, holds that the partial closure of Cell 3 in accordance with the Consent Order issued by the Superior Court, Environmental Division in *Re: Moretown Landfill Cell 3 Recertification*, No. 37-3-13 Vtec on September 13, 2013), requires a permit amendment because it constitutes a material change to the project authorized by Land Use Permit 5W1064-30. The Board will reconsider the JO in accordance with 10 V.S.A. § 6007 and the Interim Procedure on Reconsideration available online at: <http://www.nrb.state.vt.us/policies/recon.pdf>.

Replies to the reconsideration request must be received by the Natural Resources Board within 15 days of the date of this notice, or by **November 25, 2013**. Replies should specify which aspects of the reconsideration request or the JO are at issue, the reason you think the reconsideration request or JO is in error, whether you wish to present any additional evidence, and the decision requested of the Board. Any request to present additional evidence must: (1) identify the proposed new evidence, (2) explain why it is material, (3) explain why good cause exists for the person's failure to provide the additional information to the District Coordinator, (4) state whether a hearing is requested or, if any of the additional evidence can be submitted by other means, state how the additional evidence can be presented.
