PROJECT DESCRIPTION
 Install a set of seasonally removable timber stairs that will increase safety for users and prevent further erosion. The 3' wide steps will be built out of 3"x8"x14' cedar, and affixed to the ground through the use of 3' helical ground anchors and wire rope. The steps are designed to be temporary. They will be slid in place during the spring and then removed each fall. The steps will conform to the existing bank slope and not be set into the ground. An existing pull-off suffices for parking.

Act 250 Jurisdictional Opinion

Effective May 31, 2016, any appeal of this decision must be filed with the Superior Court, Environmental Division (32 Cherry Street, 2nd Floor, Ste. 303, Burlington, VT 05401) within 30 days of the date the decision was issued, pursuant to 10 V.S.A. Chapter 220. The Notice of Appeal must comply with the Vermont Rules for Environmental Court Proceedings (VRECP). The appellant must file with the Notice of Appeal the entry fee required by 32 V.S.A. § 1431, which is \$295.00. The appellant also must serve a copy of the Notice of Appeal on the Natural Resources Board, 10 Baldwin Street, Montpelier, VT 05633-3201, and on other parties in accordance with Rule 5(b)(4)(B) of the Vermont Rules for Environmental Court Proceedings.
