Subject Comments on Citation # 16ECO1180

Dear VT Natural Resource Board,

I would like to submit my experiences as comments on Citation # 16ECO1180. I live very near the VT Packinghouse Site. On the evening of Oct. 20, 2016 while walking my dog I happen to notice big grey containers setting outside of the building in the back corner of the building near the loading dock. I could not see if they had any contents. The containers seemed to stay in that area for several days as I could see them each day as I walked the dog to potty.

On Oct. 26th I happened to be outside when the rendering truck came in about 3:56 p.m. From my front door I could see that the rendering truck was not backed up to the loading dock as usual but I could hear it working to load. There was a Black River Produce delivery truck parked there for a couple of days and from my view it looked like rendering truck was backed in at an angle to get close to B.R.P. truck. Being curious I decided to take a drive. I found a spot on a road that gave me a full view of the rendering truck. The back door of the Black River Produce truck was ^{open and} full of the big grey

containers full of offal. I returned home and reported this information to Aaron Brondyke. The rendering truck left @ 4:47 p.m. I couldn't wait as the stench of rotting meat over hung the entire neighborhood for 30 minutes after they left.

Friday Oct. 28 Came in between 4:00 - 4:30 PM. Once again I could see from my yard that the truck was not backed to the dock as it used to but I could hear it working to load. Saturday as I was walking the dog I noticed there were several big grey containers outside the building. ~~Saturday~~ as I was coming home I decided I was curious enough about the containers to drive in and look. I saw that there was some offal spilled on the ground in that area so I got out and looked in containers. They were dirty with blood and small amounts of offal so I took pictures with my phone of containers & ground around containers. When I got home I sent pictures to Aaron Brondyke
