On June 16, 1987 a petition for declaratory ruling was filed with the Environmental Board by Jean Balaski-Magoon appealing Advisory Opinion #2-27 which concludes that the purchase and operation of the Eastman gravel pit by the Town of Weathersfield does not constitute a substantial change requiring an Act 250 permit.

By letter dated September 16, 1987 Douglas Richards, attorney for the Town of Weathersfield, informed the Board of the Town's determination that there is Act 250 jurisdiction and of the Town's intent to apply for an Act 250 permit.

Declaratory Ruling #193 is, therefore, dismissed.
